Immigrant Women On the Move (IWOM), is a unique job search program that aims to assist immigrant women with little or no experience in Canada find and keep a job. It includes three weeks of employment preparation workshops followed by 12 weeks of job development support. IWOM aims to help women find and keep employment by fostering a culturally sensitive, and supportive environment that is conducive to immigrant women and their unique needs.

Youth Boost is a free dynamic job search program for young people seeking a path to a brighter future. Youth Boost participants benefit from the powerful and relevant three-week pre-employment workshops. Participants will gain a competitive edge from the subsequent 12 weeks of job search support. Dedicated job developers will help participants navigate the job market, providing effective leads and matching you with jobs in line with your career path and qualifications.
